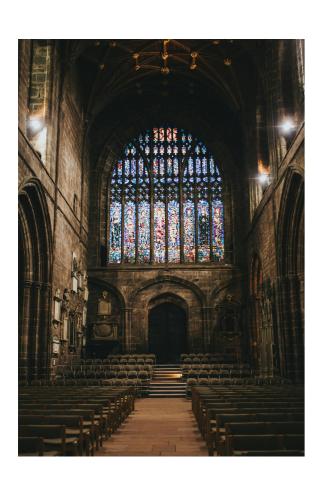


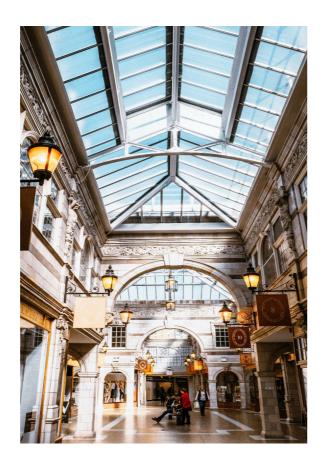
A City That Shines: Winter Events & Festivities

Music, Theatre & Winter Nights Out





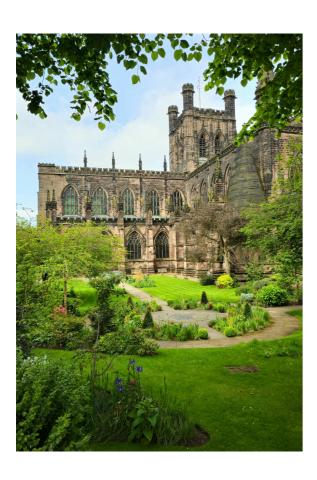
