# A Town That Shines: Winter Events & Festivities

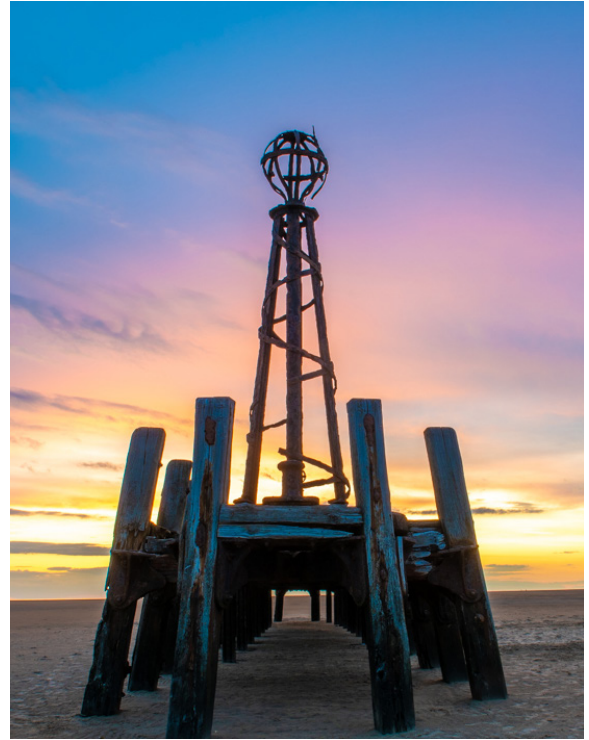
