A City That Shines: Winter Events & Festivities

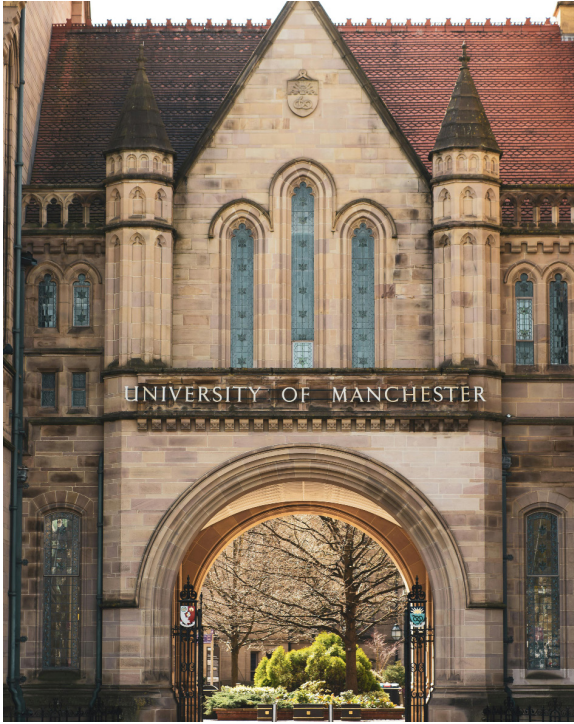
